Gerald McMahon

We dedicate this year's book to **Gerald McMahon**. As a long-standing member of The Farm, Home & Youth Foundation, Gerald has spent over 45 years serving the Montgomery County 4-H program.



Gerald graduated in 1958 from what is now known as Delaware Valley University. Then served in the U. S. Army and worked various jobs including a 6000 head beef cattle farm. After Gerald suffered a farming accident, he came back to Montgomery County. Gerald retired from Merck after 33 years of service in Quality Assurance.

Gerald first became affiliated with Montgomery County 4-H in 1978 with his children, being part of clubs such as Livestock, Furry Friends, Teen Council, Shooting Sports, and Exchange. Frequently visiting the Lansdale facility, Gerald quickly became a steadfast, committed 4-H Volunteer. Gerald supported all the clubs serving as a leader for 25+ years in the Livestock Club, and Chair of the 4-H Cabinet Advisory Board.

In 1986, Gerald began another new chapter helping the FHYF uphold its sole purpose, using the facility to support 4-H. He was an integral part of the transition from the Lansdale facility to this 4-H Facility. He was an active part of the facility development, the 4-H Market Animal Sale, and was the 4-H Fair Chair for many years.



Over his 4-H volunteer career, he received multiple awards and recognition: the Ira J. Coble Pennsylvania 4-H Beef Leader Award – PA Farm Show; Friend of Extension, and Animal Science Award from DVC. Raising 6 of his children through the 4-H programs, Gerald has 6 grandchildren currently involved or are active alumni. Gerald is a member of: Upper Fredrick Fire Co., and St. Phillip Neri Church also.



Gerald is a passionate advocate of agriculture and 4-H.

Over five decades of his dedication, innovative ideas and hard work has helped members learn more about agriculture, increase knowledge of the animal sciences and develop life skills of responsibility, leadership, and communication. Fred Seipt Memorial Page

Fred Seipt passed away in early May of this year. He was fundamental in the 4-H center as we know it today. Forty years ago, he signed the agreement of sale for our current 4-H Center. This was before the Foundation was officially established. He was a proud Penn Stater (1956 - Dairy Science), a Master Farmer, and a huge 4-H supporter!

He served on the Foundation board, as Vice President from 1984-1988, and President from 1898-1999. During his time on the board, he was instrumental in obtaining an additional 13 acres of land (where the horse rings are) from Graterford Prison in 1987. Up until the last few years you could still find him at the Fair on Saturday for the auction, or helping to drive the hay ride wagon for Montgomery County Farm Bureau.

To honor him, the "Dairy Barn" on the fairgrounds was officially named the "Fred Seipt Pavilion."
Fred will be deeply missed and we thank him for all the lives he has help shape and continues to shape though his years of

dedication and service to the 4-H and FHY Foundation.
